Summary

- The Machine Driver Operator reporting to the Airport Manager and working under the direction of the Operations Manager. This position operates a variety of heavy equipment to maintain the airport airside and groundside surfaces; performs general repairs and preventative maintenance work on all airport surfaces, buildings, facilities and equipment;
- Conducts regular airfield inspections and completes runway surface condition reports with runway coefficient of friction measurements as required;
- Performs bird and wildlife control and removal;
- This position requires being able to work shift work, overtime and respond to after hour calls to meet the airport operational and customer requirements.

Duties

- Perform airfield checks including runway surface conditions reports.
- Using a variety of heavy equipment, perform maintenance duties on airport roads, taxiways, runways, parking lots and the general airfield.
- Inspects all equipment for mechanical defects and safety on a regular basis and report any mechanical attention required.
- Snow removal and surface repair as required on airport roads, taxiways, runways, parking lots and the general airfield.
- Building Maintenance:
 - Support other trades as required
 - Cleaning of shop floors and drains

- Minor repairs such as caulking and paint touch ups
- Maintains Property Fences:
 - Retying fence as required
 - Brushing both side of fence area
 - Retying signs
 - Adjusting manual gate fixtures
- Maintains Groundside:
 - Minor hard surface repairs
 - Install replacement signs
 - General lawn care and gardening
- Maintains Hard Surfaces :
 - Line painting
 - Crack sealing
 - Minor cement work
 - Pave patching
- Maintains Equipment:
 - Performs walk around & safety checks
 - Grease all equipment as per manufacturer or Mechanic's recommendations
 - Replaces cutting edges as required
 - Replaces sweeper brushes and core
 - Performs minor maintenance (wipers blades, auto lamps, etc.)
 - Cleans and degrease equipment as required
- Maintains General Airfield by :
 - Grass and brush cutting
 - Tree removal
 - FOD and other obstacles removal
 - Wildlife control and removal
- Completes work orders and reports as per airport operating procedures.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, supervisors and the general public.
- Maintains personal protective equipment, and adherence to relevant health and safety procedures.
- Reports all equipment breakdowns, facilities malfunctions and safety violations.
- Carry out assignments as directed by the Operations and SMS Manager and assist other trades people when required
- Participates in the Airport Safety Management System, Workplace Health and Safety and other airport committees as requested by the manager.
- Will respond to emergency situations as required
- Performs other work related duties as requested by the managers which are not limited by this job description.

- Must have or be able to complete the Airport Winter Operations MDO program during the probation period.
- Must show initiative to complete other parts of the MDO Program
- Must be able to complete the health and safety modules during the probation period

- Must be fluent in both written and spoken English.
- Must have and maintain a Class "DZ".
- Industry Canada Radio licence for airport use within 30 days
- AVOP for airport use within 30 days
- Must have three year's work experience in the operations of heavy equipment
